## **HP Labs develops gesture-based keyboard:** Researchers at HP Labs In-

dia have developed a gesture-based keyboard (GKB), a pen-based technology that the company said is a pathbreaking innovation that could revolutionise communication in Indian scripts. Executives of HP, a technology solutions provider to consumers, businesses and institutions globally, said the technology could potentially open up the power of com-puting to vast numbers of new users, all in their own language and without prior knowledge of English or typing. "The gesture-based keyboard can help bridge the digital divide by simplifying the use of it," said Dick Lampman, HP senior vicepresident, research and director, HP Labs, at a news conference. Company executives said GKB also holds the potential for Indic languages derived from the Devanagari and Tamil scripts to be used in a similar manner. That could benefit more than 1.5 billion non-English speaking people and other phonetic script users. PTI
